JUNIOR VICE PRESIDENT - Job Description

Fixed Allowance: – possibly increases each year – this includes Leamington Allowance.

Attend: Executive/Council & AGM Meetings

Kent Semi-Final and Final Event plus Mollie Cleggett Final

Attend your Divisions finals day (if President or SVP are from different division then you will be the figure head).

Junior VP responsible for attendance book for Past Presidents/life members & Executive at Council Meetings.

AMY ROSE – UNDER 31 SQUAD – Junior VP responsible for attending any event as required – usually involved the Under 25 Boys v Girls

EXECUTIVE MATCHES

When available all executive matches to play along with other executive officers and past presidents (you will be expected to make a payment towards cost of match) all travel non claimable.

John's/Walker Matches –Expected to attend all trials, and matches, travel to coach non claimable, you will be expected to cover cost of meal at match.

When Presidential Team has events that overlap – i.e. Div Finals, One Day Events be available to assist at event if required. Secretary will confirm what events are needed to be covered.

County Friendly Matches – Attend all matches whether home or away. As these are part of Junior Vice Presidents duties, any meal provided is paid for by County as you are expected to attend as part of your duties. You will be expected to support the President and County, keep a running score sheet along with the opposing County's Junior Vice President. Junior Vice President has the reserve set of place names and County Flag and should be carried at all times. Junior Vice responsible for quizzes on coaches (no prizes but money collected as donation from players goes to President for her Charity).

Refreshments will be provided by County at Div Finals, Semi Finals, and Finals & Mollie Cleggett. Plus any one day event you attend in your capacity as Junior Vice President.

National Championships – Leamington – you are expected to support the President – usually Junior Vice President spends first week at Leamington – it does give you the opportunity of meeting the other Junior Vice Presidents. Support Kent Players playing in the Championships.

Presidential Tour – In your year as President this is entirely your choice (County have no dealings with this tour).

KCBA Ladies Luncheon – attend and support the President, help with the preparation of venue. Prepare and make a speech to Toast all the County Winners

Attend President's Day – support the President as and when needed.

KCBA Ladies v Men – Attend and support President and Play in the match.

Undertake any other duties/tasks as may arise during playing Season. At your discretion attend any function not listed, but this will be at a cost to yourself.

In general attend all events you can. The more events you attend the more you will learn what the President has to do – It is your responsibility to see that the President and Senior Vice President are being looked after.
